There was no testing in December. Testing will be done again on Saturday, January 16th.

52 CONTACTS CHALLENGE

As we reach the end of the year, and as we transition leadership in ARES to a new section emergency coordinator, I thought it would be a good time to bring up a challenge I have for encouraging on-air practice:

During the calendar year, log 2-way contacts with at least 52 unique contacts with at least 52 unique callsigns in any combination of voice, data, and Morse code. Of those 52 con-tacts, no more than 10 can be on any one repeater or linked repeater system (e.g. DMR).

Of the 52 contacts, at least 5 should be simplex.

Contacts you make while operating at a multi-operator station/event (e.g. Field Day) can count toward your total. Digital data use is strongly encouraged (e.g. Winlink, RTTY, fldigi, FT8, APRS). Bonus: submit your log in ADIF format to a Winlink address; don't forget the // WL2K subject prefix.

Clarifications:

DMR counts as voice unless you are passing arbitrary data in a digital format (e.g. messaging). For Winlink, if you connect with an au-tomatically controlled data station (e.g. node or igate), that is the station that counts as your contact.

While demonstrating that you can send/ receive email via Telnet Winlink is very useful, it does not count toward these 52 contacts of on-air experience.

At this point, it is not a requirement for ARES membership, but we are presenting it as a challenge. Let's see how many of you can do this!
